WHEREAS, pending state action regarding sex offender supervision standards and assessment of risk, along with a desire to have the most complete information on a defendant, has led to the possibility of completing assessments of sex offenders prior to sentencing; and

WHEREAS, the results of the sex offender risk assessment will be included in the Presentence report and entail the potential risk that the defendant poses to the safety and security of the community as well as recommendations for specialized conditions of probation, if applicable; and

WHEREAS, as a result, the need for a form notifying the Probation Department of the desire for such an assessment has been identified;

IT IS ORDERED that, the attached "Sex Offender Assessment Notification Form" be used by the Court to notify the Probation Department of orders for assessments. Use of this form will ensure that assessments are scheduled and completed within 45 days.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that "Additional Special Conditions of Probation" which address the unique issues that individuals appearing before the Court for sexual offenses are approved. The special terms provide a framework to enhance the effectiveness of community supervision and protection.

In addition to the Standard and Special Terms and Conditions of Probation as set forth by the Court, IT IS ORDERED that the Defendant will comply with the following additional conditions:

- 1. The Defendant shall not initiate, establish or maintain contact with any male or female child under the age of 18, or attempt to do so, without the prior written approval of the Probation Officer, as may be amended. The Defendant shall sign and abide by the Probation Department definition of "no contact".
- 2. The Defendant shall not reside with any child under the age of 18 or contact any children in any manner without the prior written approval of the Court or Probation Officer.
- 3. The Defendant shall not enter onto the premises, travel past, or loiter near where victim resides without prior written approval of the Probation Officer. The Defendant shall not correspond, have telephone contact or communicate with the victim through a third party.
- 4. The Defendant shall not go to or loiter near places primarily used by children under the age of 18 such as, but not limited to, schools, school yards, parks, playgrounds, arcades, swimming pools, parades, carnivals, circuses, etc. without the prior written approval of the Probation Officer.
- 5. The Defendant shall not knowingly date or socialize with any person who has children under the age of 18 without prior written approval of the Probation Officer.
- 6. The Defendant shall attend, actively participate, and successfully complete sex offender treatment and remain in such treatment at the direction of the Probation Officer.
- 7. The Defendant shall submit to any program of psychological, physiological, or risk assessment at the direction of the Probation Officer, including the penile plethysmograph and/or the polygraph, to assist in treatment, planning and monitoring.

- 8. The Defendant shall authorize therapists to disclose to the Court and Probation Department information about your attendance and progress in treatment.
- 9. The Defendant shall register as a sex offender with the Sheriff of the County in which he or she resides within 10 days of sentence and/or change of residence pursuant to A.R.S §13-3821 and §13-3822 and comply with D.M.V. identification requirements.
- 10. The Defendant shall submit to DNA testing pursuant to A.R.S. §31-281.
- 11. The Defendant shall abide by any curfew imposed by the Probation officer.
- 12. The Defendant shall not possess, or in any way attempt to obtain by telephone or any other instrument, any sexually stimulating or sexually orientated material in any form as deemed inappropriate by treatment staff, or patronize any adults-only establishment where such material is available.
- 13. The Defendant shall be responsible for his or her appearance including but not limited to the wearing of undergarments and appropriate non-sexually stimulating clothing in locations where another person may be expected to view the Defendant.
- 14. The Defendant shall not possess, use, or have personal access to any computer or similar equipment that has Internet capability without prior written approval of the Probation Officer.
- 15. The Defendant shall not hitchhike or pick up hitchhikers.

- 16. The Defendant shall not operate a motor vehicle without prior written approval of the Probation Officer.
- 17. An in-custody Defendant may be released to the Probation Department and returned to the Mohave County Jail only for the purpose to attend, participate, and complete any and all sex offender testing, therapy, and counseling as may be required by the Probation Department without further court order.
