This Agreement shall be in effect unless either party to the Agreement notifies the other, in writing, that paper copies of minute entries will again be generated and mailed. The Agreement shall be in a form similar to the form attached hereto.
- (2) If the parties or the Clerk of Superior Court, Mohave County, enter into an Agreement for electronic distribution of minute entries, then e-mail shall be sufficient to comply with Rule 58(e) requirements.
 - (3) This Order shall remain in effect until further Order of this Court.
